## Grade Levels

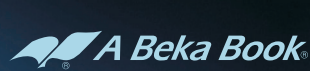
For the 2010-2011 school year we will be offering K4 thru 8th grade.

- Interview(s) with parents/guardians
- CCA assessment results
- Parent/Guardian commitment to uphold all school policies and procedures
- Student's desire to attend CCA

# FAQs

## ■ Why do you only offer grades K4 through 8th?

As the church pastoral staff prayed regarding God's desire for us to do a school, two things became evident. It had to be God's will for us and we needed to do it right. It became apparent that it would be best for the church and the community to start small and grow into the school. We began in 2007 with K4 - 4th grade; added 5th & 6th grade in 2008; 7th grade in 2009 and now as we begin our 2010-2011 year we are adding 8th grade.

## ■ Will my student be able to graduate from the Academy?

**Yes!** Each year we plan on adding another grade level. We currently have Middle School for the 2010-2011 year and each following year will add one High School grade level.

## ■ What makes CCA different from other schools?

**Calvary Chapel Academy** is a Christ-centered, nondenominational academy serving K4 through 8th grade. Our vision is to unleash each student's God-given talents through Christ-centered academic excellence. We are devoted to developing the whole person and instilling a lifelong passion for learning, leading and serving.

## ■ Are you accredited?

**Not yet.** This will be our fourth year as a school. From the time a school is open, it takes 4 years to earn accreditation. We will be receiving our accreditation this fall through the Association of Christian Teachers & Schools (ACTS).

## ■ What is the average class size?

The average class size will range from 18-20 students in a class.

## ■ What type of student are you looking for?

We look for students who are motivated to pursue higher education, to grow in a personal faith in Jesus Christ and to serve the Lord, their families, and their communities.

## ■ Do CCA students wear a uniform?

We have a 'Standard of Dress' for our students to wear. The standard of dress consists of navy, black or khaki pants/skirt/shorts and solid-colored polo shirts in either short or long sleeve. Standard of dress helps students to focus on Christ by eliminating undue focus on clothing and designer labels and a preoccupation with outward appearance. We want to be imitators of God by focusing on the heart.
